



HAPPY DAYS PRESCHOOL & CHILDCARE

FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

Happy Days is a nonprofit organization and does not receive funding from the school district. With the childcare center license, we are obligated to hire teachers that have a formal education background. Ultimately, this means your child will receive a top-notch preschool education, but our tuition must reflect that quality to retain teachers.

Tuition Breakdown for 2022-2023 school year

- Full school day care: 8-3:30, \$40/day
- Morning care: 8-12pm, \$22/day
- Afternoon care: 12-3:30 pm, \$20/day

Tuition will be paid in advance, one month at a time. You will receive an email with your monthly statement by the 21st of each month. Payment will be due by the first school day of the month. If payment has not been received by the 10th of the month, a \$20 late fee will apply. If you fall more than one month behind on tuition, your child will not be able to attend unless full payment is received. There will not be any credit for sick days or vacation days. Your monthly payment will be based on your child's registration days and the number of school days in that month. Please see the enclosed calendar.

Payment options: cash, check, venmo. A 2% additional fee will be charged if using venmo.

Tuition includes a morning and afternoon snack provided. Lunches will need to be brought from home if you are sending your child for the full day, or need them to eat lunch prior to 12pm pick up.

You are required to pick up your child on time. In the event you are late to pick up, there will be a \$10 charge for arrival 5 minutes after posted end time. An additional \$15 fee will be applied for arrival between 6 and 15 minutes after posted end time. If a parent/guardian has not arrived to pick up their child, and cannot be reached by phone within 15 minutes of closing time, a \$50 fee will be applied, and we will call the emergency contact listed on their enrollment forms.
